- 2. All entries must have been made in the last 11 months.
- 3. Limit to only one entry per category.
- 4. No store bought items embellished or decorated.
- 5. Entries must be Seminole made.
- 6. Mixed media can be no bigger than 18" x 24".
- 7. Deadline is Thursday, January 29, 2026 from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm. Drop-off location: Hard Rock Grand Ballroom.
- 8. Absolutely no late entries will be accepted.
- 9. All prizes are subject to taxation.
- 10. All entries must be framed and ready for hanging to ensure proper display.
- 11. Entries that do not comply with rules will not be accepted.
- 12. One form per contestant for all entries submitted into Fine Arts Contest
- 13.ANY PERSON BREAKING RULES WILL BE BANNED FOR 12 MONTHS FROM TRIBAL FAIR, INDIAN DAY, or ANY/ALL CONTESTS.
- 14. Seminole Tribal Fair and Culture Department are not responsible for damaged, lost or stolen items.
- 15. Pick up entries will be Sunday, February 1, 2026 between noon to 5:00 pm in the Grand Ballroom. The Culture Department is not responsible for entries not picked up.
- 16. Artwork must be family friendly, absolutely no nudity and or obscene language is allowed. Entries that violate the rule will be disqualified.
